Dear Parents,

As P.4-6 and P.1-3 will resume classes on 8th June and 15th June respectively, we would like to urge you to maintain vigilance against the COVID-19 disease at school. Cooperation from parents and students is essential for us to maintain a clean and safe environment. We call on your support to step up environmental hygiene in the household, and, on top of that, strictly implement the following measures:

1. Pay attention to the health condition of your child. He/She should stay away from school and see a doctor immediately if symptoms, especially fever, are detected.
2. Take your child's temperature before he/ she goes to school every day. Fill in the "Temperature Record Sheet" (will be provided by school when classes resume and attached in handbook) and sign your name. Your child should return the completed sheet to us daily.
3. To prevent infection, please ask your child to wear a mask (also applicable when taking school buses, nanny vans or other transportation) and bring tissue paper to school every day.
4. To keep teachers' informed of the health condition of students, please complete the "2019 Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Declaration form for travel history and health status of students" (see attached google form) to provide us with the following information:
 - 4.1 travel history of your child outside Hong Kong in the past 14 days;
 - 4.2 whether your child has a confirmed COVID-19 infection;
 - 4.3 the health status of those taking care of your child, or those living with your child;
 - 4.4 the current health status of your child.
5. After the resumption of classes, you are requested to notify the School Office at 2577-5188 immediately in case of any of the following situations, to facilitate our prompt action in taking contingency measures and informing the EDB:
 - 5.1 your child has been confirmed to have the COVID-19 infection; or
 - 5.2 your child has been classified as having "close contact" with a person infected with COVID-19*

Please return the declaration form before the first day of class resumption. Students who have contracted the virus and have recovered, but are still within the 14-day quarantine period must not come to school.

With concerted efforts by all parties, we look forward to overcoming the adversities of the pandemic so that students, teachers and parents can resume normal living and healthy lives.

*In general, close contact means having cared for, having lived with, or having had direct contact with respiratory secretions and body fluids of a confirmed patient.
