## No.20021 : 'Happy-Go-Buddies' Emotional Health Questionnaire

Dear P.4 to P.6 Parents,

Baptist Oi Kwan Social Service (BOKSS) has been running the 'Happy-Go-Buddies' project since 2011. It aims to identify factors that contribute to children's good mental health, so as to establish preventive and early intervention work in the community. The project includes an emotional health questionnaire, a student group and parent and student seminars.

Our school will cooperate with BOKSS to hold the 'Happy-Go-Buddies: Emotional Health Questionnaire' activity. Students will be invited to fill in the questionnaire in the Personal Growth Lesson. The questionnaire takes around 30 minutes and the contents are related to the student's emotional well-being, sources of stress, interpersonal relationships and family relationships. The questionnaire will be passed to the researchers at BOKSS for analyzing. The results will be given to the school for reference and the school will follow-up the screened students. In addition, BOKSS will integrate the data from all the participating schools in Hong Kong, to carry out further analysis and research. The results will be used by BOKSS on planning emotional health services, while at the same time, allowing different educational parties in Hong Kong to have a better understanding on children's emotional well-being. All personal information collected in the questionnaire will be confidential. Identification codes will be used which will only be known by the researchers.
