No. 20037: Face to Face Class Suspension for P.1-P.3 Students

20th November, 2020

Dear P.1-P.3 Parents,

In consideration of the development of the upper respiratory tract infection and novel coronavirus epidemic, the Centre for Health Protection have decided that P.1-P.3 classes will be suspended for 14 days starting from Monday 23rd November.

In response to this announcement, we will adopt the following measures:

1. From 23rd November to 4th December, P.1-P.3 classes will be conducted via Zoom, using the current half-day timetable. The last lesson on Day 6 (Class Teacher Period) will be cancelled. P.4-P.6 half day face-to-face classes will carry on as usual.
2. The tentative date to resume face-to-face classes for P.1-P.3 is 7th December.
3. The examination dates for P.1-P.3 will be postponed to 14th - 17th December. The P.1-P.3 lessons on 1st - 4th December will follow the Day 1 to Day 4 timetable. The examination dates for P.4-P.6 remain unchanged.
4. Points to note for online learning:
 - 4.1. Students should login to the Zoom lesson (please see the attachment) at 8:15 am. The class teacher will take attendance and the number of absent days will be recorded on the report card.
 - 4.2. If your child needs to take sick leave or casual leave, please inform your class teacher through ClassDojo before 8:15 am, or it will be treated as truancy and will be recorded on the report card.
 - 4.3. Students should login to the Zoom lessons in their own name.
 - 4.4. During the online lessons, students should activate the "Start Video" mode and be visible on screen, or it will be treated as truancy and will be recorded on the report card.
 - 4.5. Once students are logged in to the Zoom lessons at 8:15 am they should not log out until the last lesson ends, even during recess.
5. Chinese, English, Mathematics and General Studies lessons will be recorded. The video will be uploaded to the Rainbow One\ Bookshelf\ Free to Read before 4:00 pm everyday.



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6. If students do not have an iPad or a computer that can access the internet, you can come to the school office on Monday to Friday, 8:00 am – 4:00 pm to borrow one as soon as possible.
7. For those who join the online Chinese or Mathematics Enhancement Class in the afternoon, please attend the class according to the timetable.
8. We will conduct a deep clean of the entire building.

To reduce the impact of class suspension to your child's learning, please assist and supervise your child to join the online lessons.
