P.6	 Half-day face-to-face classes will resume from 22nd February to 5th March, all students depart at 12:50 p.m. (except for the exam period) 2nd Term SSPA Exam will take place from 1st - 3rd March, all students depart at 11:10 a.m. During the exam period, all after school online Chinese and Mathematics Enhancement Classes will be suspended. Half-day online lessons conducted via Zoom will take place from 8th March until further notice.
