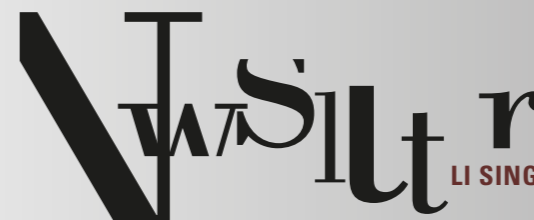


Orientation Day
